Parts	Types of questions	Skills to test
I (10 points)	Seen vocabulary (<u>words in blue</u>) from Units 1 & 2 - Cloze	- Understanding vocabulary in context
II (8 points)	Reading TWO unseen passages on narratives - Multiple choice	- Identifying the topic/main idea/purpose - Identifying details - Recognizing and understanding vocabulary in context - Inferencing - Recognizing reference
III (7 points)	Reading ONE unseen passage on technology - Multiple choice	- Identifying the topic/main idea/details and conclusion - Recognizing and understanding vocabulary in context - Inferencing - Recognizing reference
IV (20 points)	Writing two paragraphs of the advantages AND disadvantages from different sources given. Students are required to write TWO advantages in one paragraph and TWO disadvantages in the other paragraph by <u>using the reasons and examples/evidence from the sources only.</u> They MUST NOT add any more reasons/examples of their own.	Writing two well-organized paragraphs (150-200 words) about the advantages AND disadvantages of the given topic
