

## Online Learning: Be Used To

## A confusing pair is 'used to' and 'be used to'. Let's start with:

- I. used to (modal verb): If something used to happen, it happened regularly or all the time in the past, but does not happen now.
  - (a) Statement Form: <u>Subject + used to + verb 1 (or infinitive without 'to')</u> For example:
  - Yaya <u>used to</u> visit the Chulalongkorn University Language Institute two years ago.
  - (b) Negative Form: Subject + did not use to + verb 1
    For example:
  - Yaya <u>did not use to</u> visit the Chulalongkorn University Language Institute two years ago.
  - (c) Interrogative Form: <u>Did + subject + use to + verb 1?</u>
  - For example:
  - <u>Did</u> Yaya <u>use to</u> visit the Chulalongkorn University Language Institute two vears ago?
- II. be/get used to + V.ing/something is an expression for a present habit.

**be/get used to + V.ing/something**: to have experienced something enough so that it doesn't seem surprising or unfamiliar to you

- (a) Statement Form: Subject + be/get used to + V.ing/something
  For example:
- Tata is used to having coffee in the morning.
- (b) Negative Form: <u>Subject + is/are not used to + V.ing/something</u> For example:
- Tata <u>is not used to having</u> coffee in the morning.
- (c) Interrogative Form: <u>Is/Are + subject + used to + V.ing/something?</u> For example:
- Is Yaya used to having coffee in the morning?
- Do you believe that Yaya is/was used to having coffee in the morning?
