

How to Improve Your English Proficiency

To achieve further improvement in your English proficiency, consider the advice below.

Vocabulary	In order to enrich your vocabulary further, you should learn specialized terms in fields such as medicine, economics and politics. Instead of studying words in isolation, practice word mapping, which involves making diagrams of associations between words in similar fields (for example, doctor - prescription).
Conversational Expression	Now you need to progress to high school level expressions used in everyday life. Try to improve your comprehension of entire conversations. When you learn a new expression, consider both the meanings of the words and the way in which they are used.
Listening	In order to progress to the next level and understand the finer details of the conversation, you need to focus on words with less emphasis as well as words that are emphasized. Read scripts while listening to spoken text and try to identify the unstressed words. Then practice your pronunciation, paying particular attention to the difference between stressed and unstressed words.
